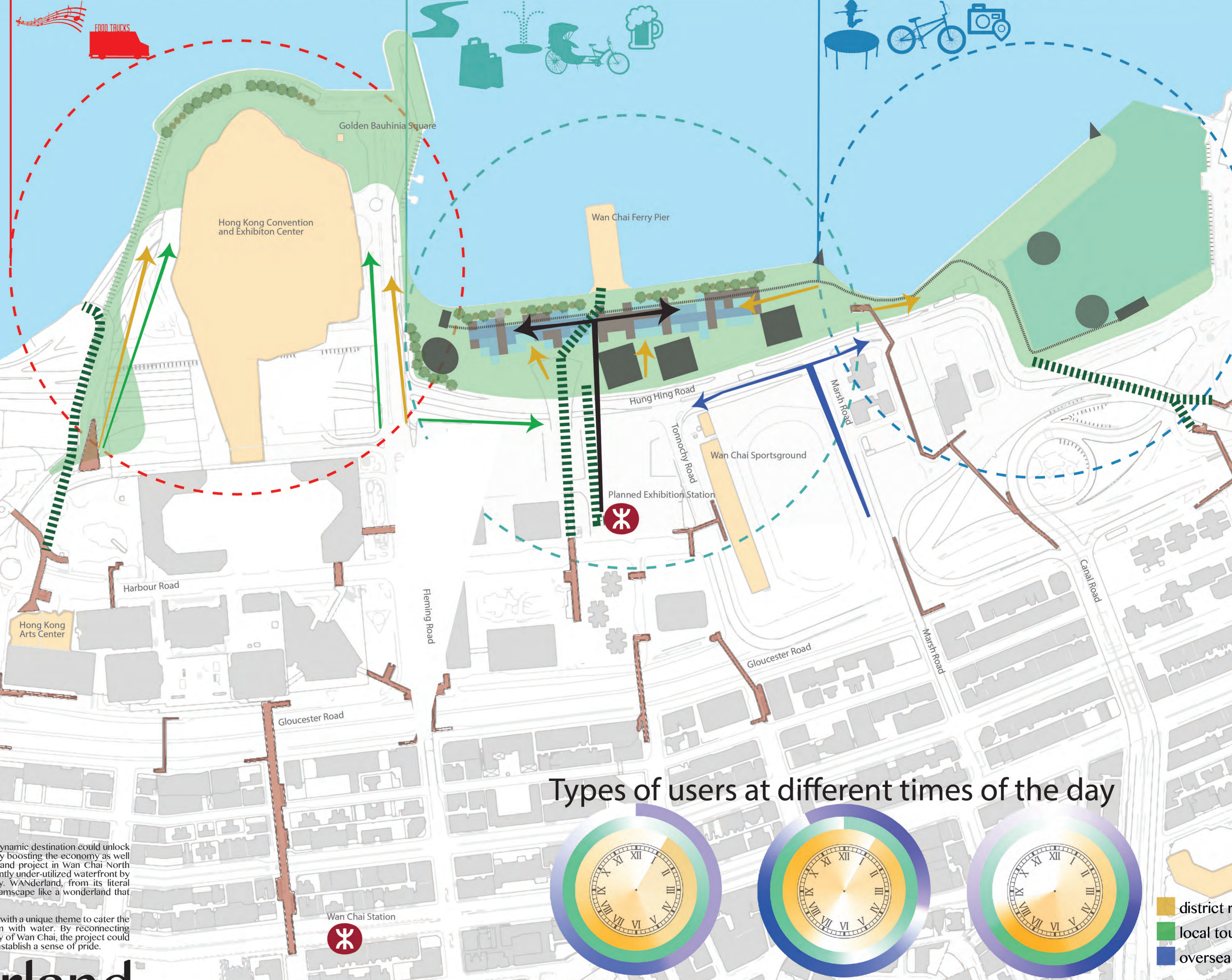

Transforming a harbourside, or waterfront into a dynamic destination could unlock great potential of an area or even the whole city by boosting the economy as well as triggering positive social effect. The WANDerland project in Wan Chai North aims to encourage public participation in the currently under-utilized waterfront by promoting mixed use, diversity and sustainability. WANDerland, from its literal meaning, suggests that the space is an urban dreamscape like a wonderland that encourages people to 'wander' and explore.

The whole stretch is divided into three zones, each with a unique theme to cater the need of different users and promote interaction with water. By reconnecting people to local culture of and reminding the history of Wan Chai, the project could help building up a strong community identity and establish a sense of pride.

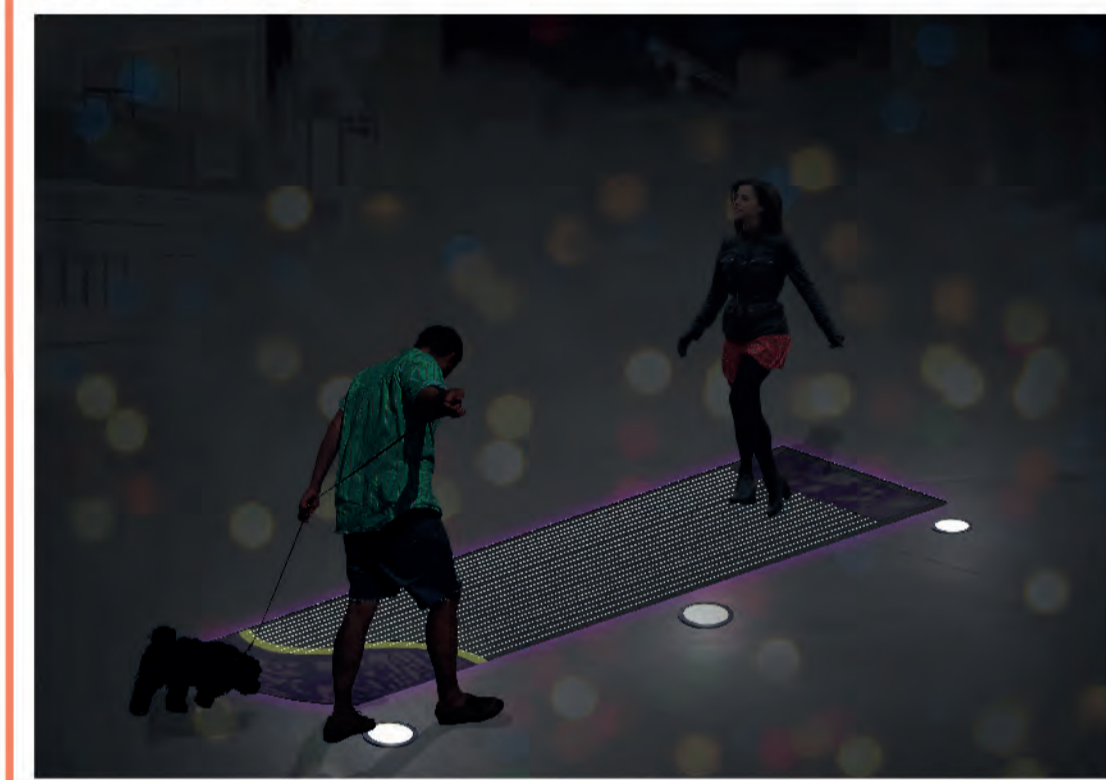

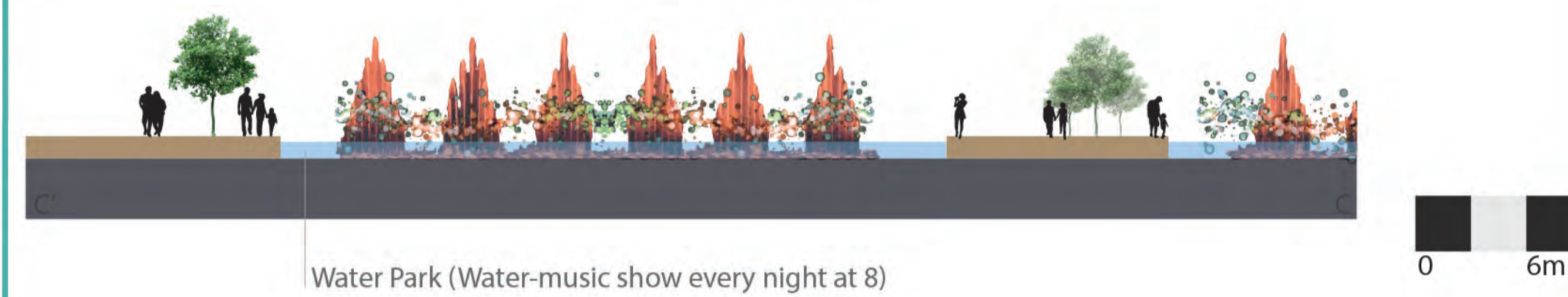

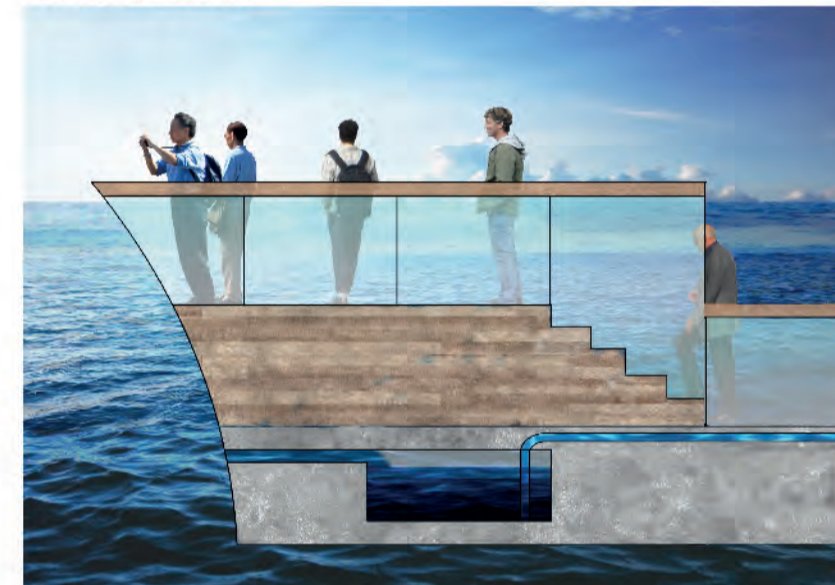

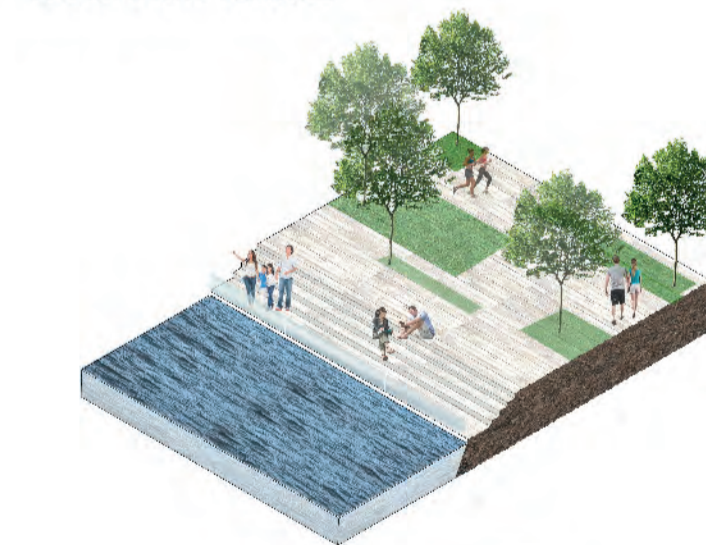

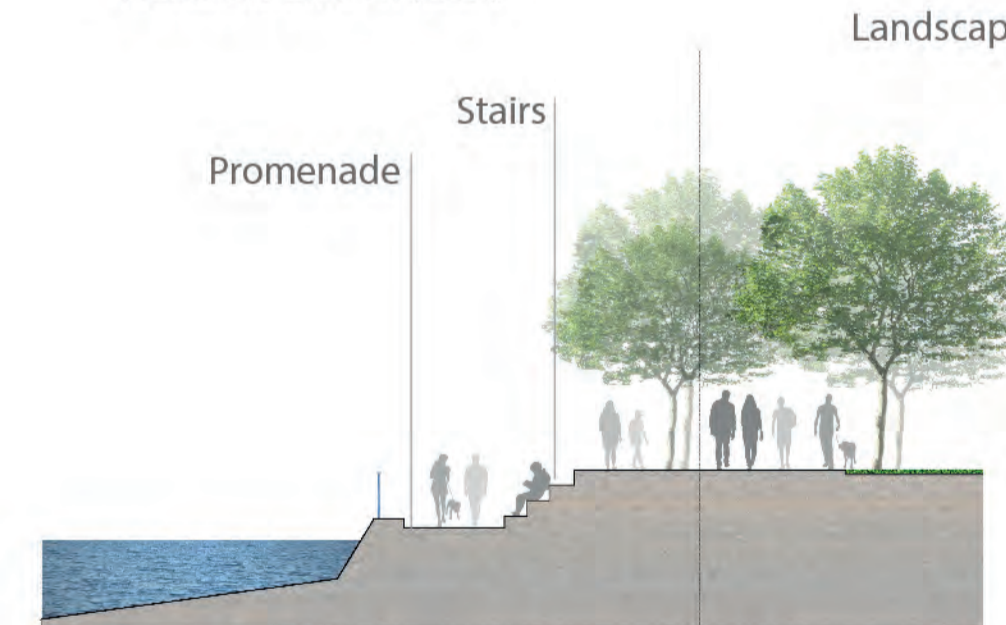

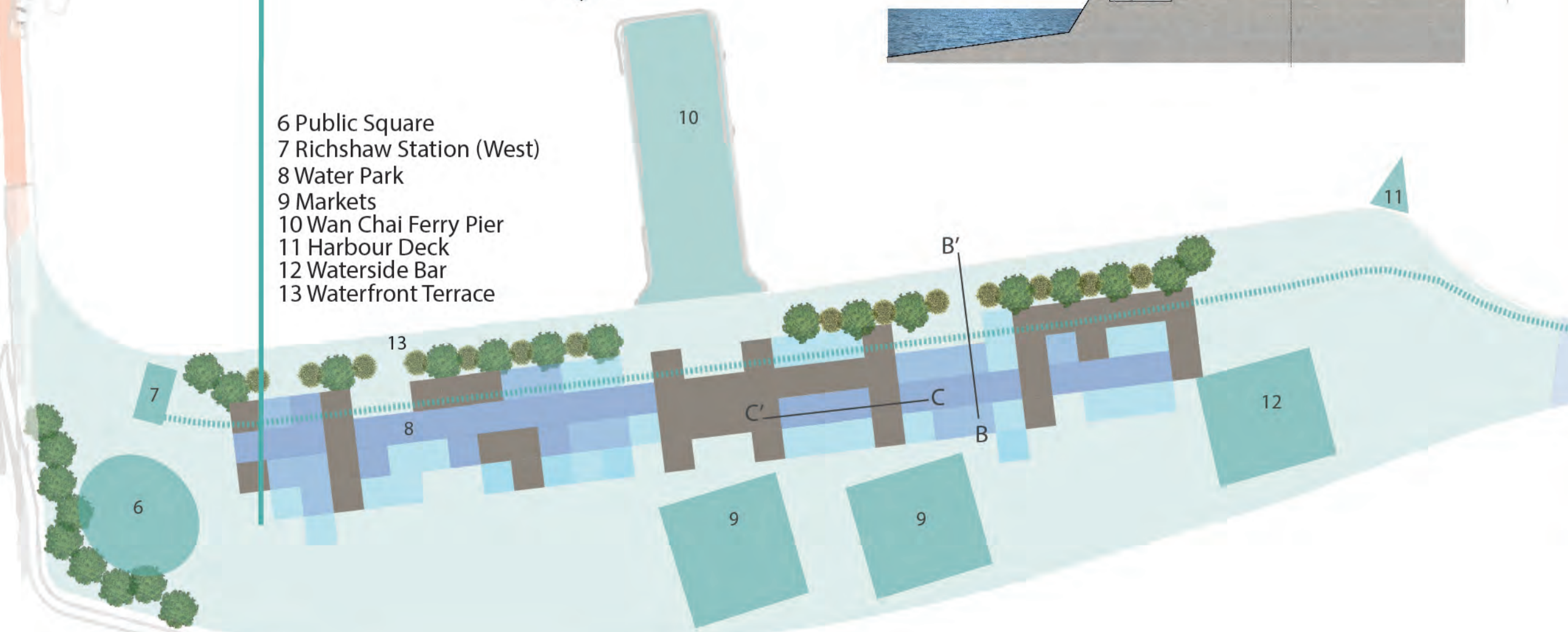

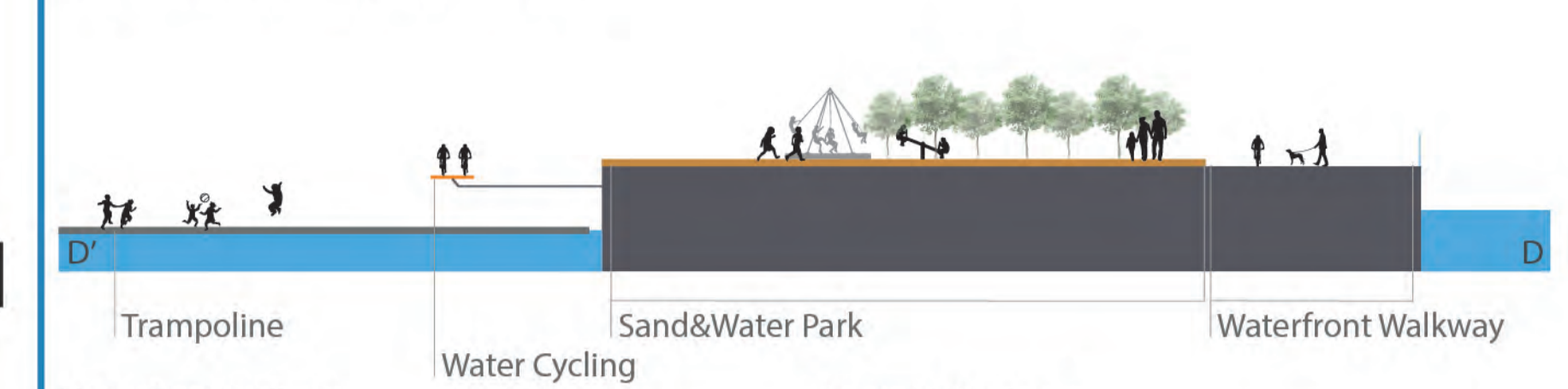

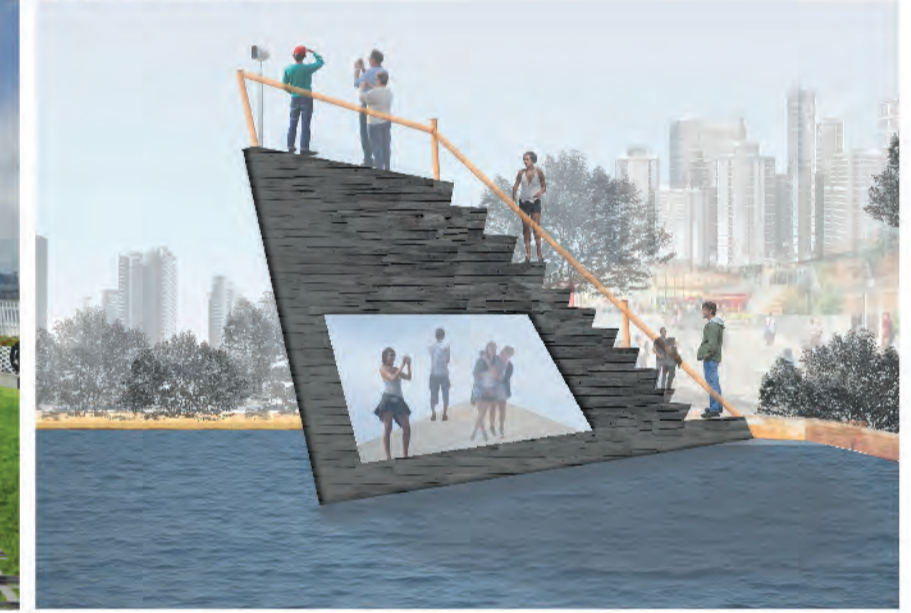

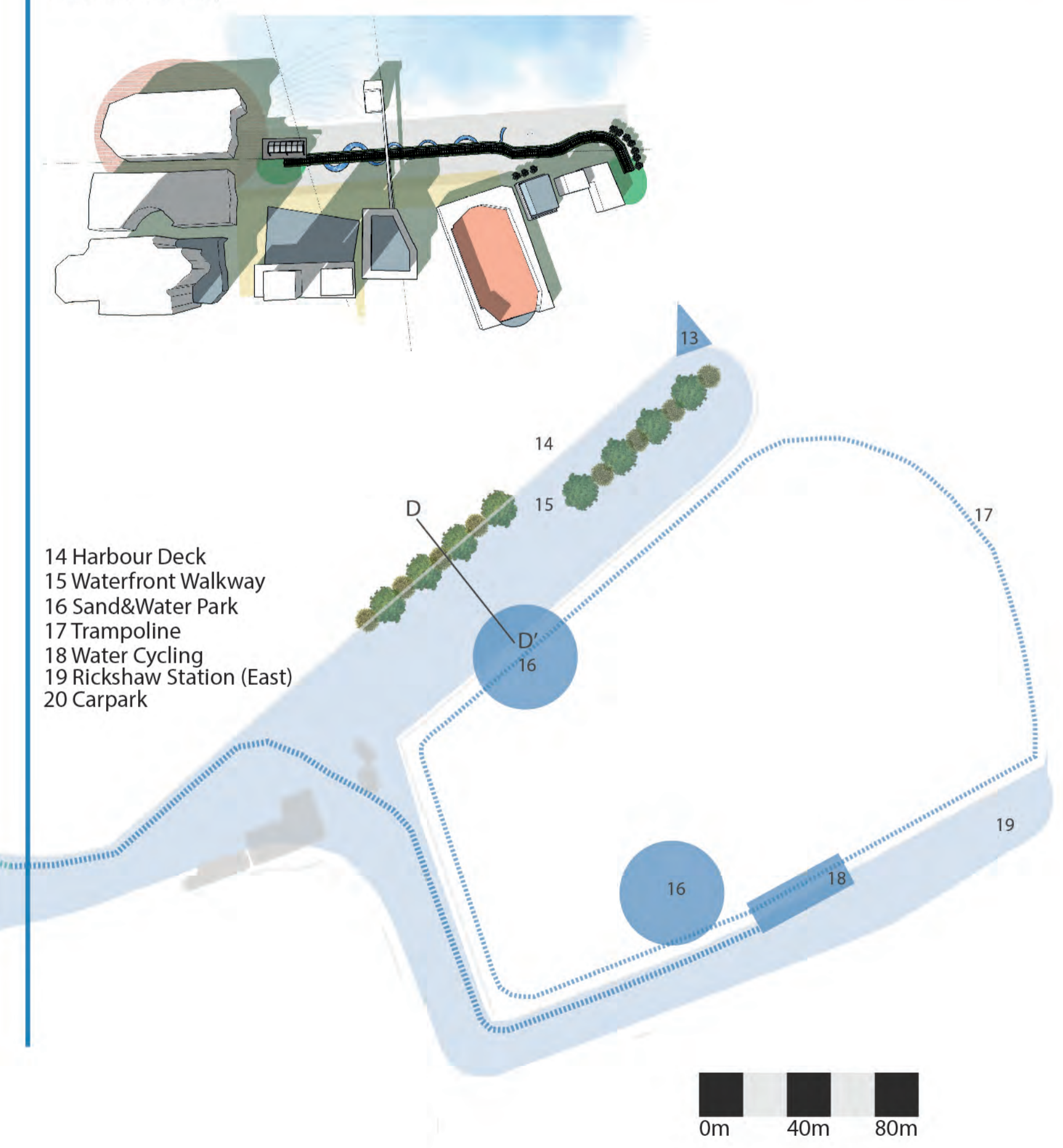
