Kowloon City District Urban Renewal Forum **Terms of Reference of the Education Working Group**

Purpose

This paper aims to propose the terms of reference of the Education Working Group to Members of the Kowloon City District Urban Renewal Forum (“DURF”).

Background

2. According to the terms of reference of DURF, DURF plays a role in educating the public by organising outreach programme to all the relevant stakeholders, with a view to fostering district partnership in urban renewal work. A variety of activities were held in different ways to promote public education work since the establishment of DURF. At the meeting on 12 December 2012, Members discussed the ways on how the role of DURF in educating the public could be strengthened. Members opined that information could be released through school networks in the districts or competitions could be organized to arouse interests of students and parents on DURF. These activities could be organized to complement with the Stage 2 Public Engagement (PE). There were also comments suggesting that DURF could cooperate with the electronic media for promotion. After deliberation, Members endorsed the establishment of the Education Working Group, which is responsible for planning and promotion of public education activities in relation to urban renewal work. The Secretariat of DURF has subsequently invited Members to join the working group by email, and a total of nine Members have shown interest to participate.

Terms of Reference

3. The Secretariat has proposed the following terms of reference of the Education Working Group for Members' consideration:

- (a) planning and promotion of public education outreach activities to raise public awareness on urban renewal work and the work of DURF; and
- (b) to report the work progress to DURF.

4. The Secretariat will arrange working group meetings to follow up the public education work after Members have endorsed the terms of reference of the Education Working Group. With regard to how the public education activities can complement with the Stage 2 Public Engagement as raised by Members, the Secretariat suggests that invitation letters can be sent to schools or organisations in the district inviting them to the roving exhibitions of the Stage 2 PE, and the Secretariat will arrange presentation of the content of exhibitions with a view to promoting public education and the Stage 2 PE. The Working Group can consider this proposal.

Advice Sought

5. Members are invited to provide comments on the terms of reference of the Education Working Group, and consider whether the terms of reference should be endorsed.
