

### No. 21 - Pak Tai To Yan

#### Site

The site consists of ravines on the north face of the ridge. The area is about 32 hectares.

### Date of Designation

20 September 1979

## Special Scientific Interest

The ravines are forested and are of high botanical interest. Rare plant species are knwon, e.g. <u>Colysis wrightii, Impatiens hongkongensis</u>.

### Degree of Hazard

There is the risk of hillfire and increasing pressure for recreational development.

# Recommended Protection Measures

The site is within the Lam Tsuen Country Park. Adequate priority should be given to the protection of the site within the framework of country park services. Recreational development should be channelled away from the site.
