

### No. 29 - Castle Peak

### <u>Site</u>

The site consists of the summit and the ravines on the east and west faces. The area of the site is about 73.7 hectares.

### Date of Designation

5 February 1980

# Special Scientific Interest

The grassy summit is the most important site for <u>Platycodon grandiflora</u>, a rare plant which is protected under the Forest and Countryside Ordinance.

The ravines are forested with interesting and rare plant species, e.g. Uvaria hamiltonii.

## Degree of Hazard

Development will pose risks to the vegetation in the area.

#### Recommended Protection Measures

The Agriculture & Fisheries Department should be advised of, and consulted on any development proposals which will affect the vicinity of the site or the site itself.
